<p>If we assign 3 points for each first place vote, two points for each 2nd place vote and 1 point for each 3rd place vote, the totals would be:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. MELT – 11 POINTS 2. TIPS – 9 POINTS 3. CAMI – 7 POINTS 4. ANLC – 6 POINTS 5. Continue Search – 6 POINTS 6. CPS – 4 POINTS 7. CIAN – 3 POINTS 8. MPSC – 2 POINTS 9. EPSAN – 2 POINTS 10. AEMCTC – 2 POINTS 11. AMLC – 1 POINT 12. AMSC – 1 POINT 	<p>Most occurrences in the top three: MELT with 5 (TIPS was 2nd with 4)</p> <p>Most occurrences in the number 1 slot: MELT with 3 (“Continue Search” was 2nd with 2)</p>
	<p>If we factor in people’s level of happiness with the choice of names, everyone gave a “shrug”, except for Persons D and E, who gave a “Yay!” and both choose MELT as their number 1 pick.</p>
