There are lots of different ways to think about how to choose a name based on the responses to the online survey.

Looking at the top three choices of everyone who responded to the online survey...

If we assign 3 points for each first place vote, two points for each 2nd place vote and 1 point for each 3rd place vote, the totals would be:

- 2. TIPS 9 POINTS
- 3. CAMI 7 POINTS
- 4. ANLC 6 POINTS
- 5. Continue Search 6 POINTS
- 6. CPS 4 POINTS
- 7. CIAN 3 POINTS
- 8. MPSC 2 POINTS
- 9. EPSAN 2 POINTS
- 10. AEMCTC 2 POINTS
- 11. AMLC 1 POINT
- 12. AMSC 1 POINT

Most occurrences in the top three: MELT with 5 (TIPS was 2nd with 4)

Most occurrences in the number 1 slot: MELT with 3 ("Continue Search" was 2nd with 2)

If we factor in people's level of happiness with the choice of names, everyone gave a "shrug", except for Persons D and E, who gave a "Yay!" and both choose **MELT** as their number 1 pick. Looking at the order of preferences of all 12 choices, for all 9 respondents: Total (lower is better), Average, Mode and Range...
