

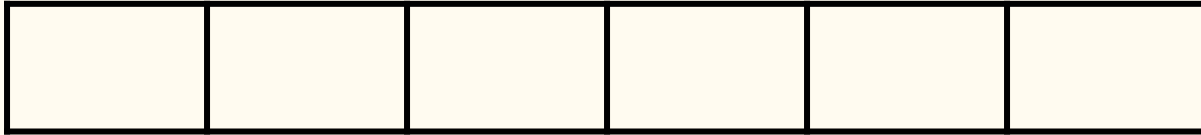

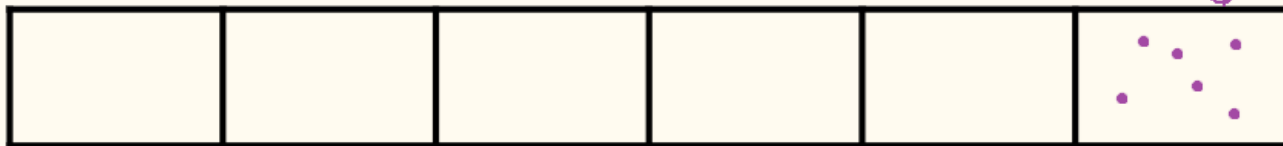
An interesting machine...

When there are two dots in the same box...

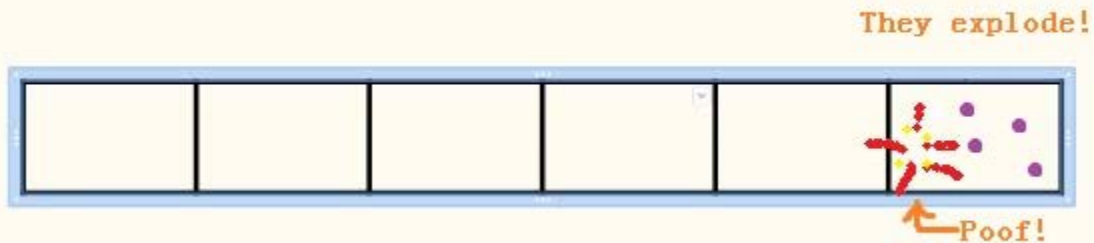

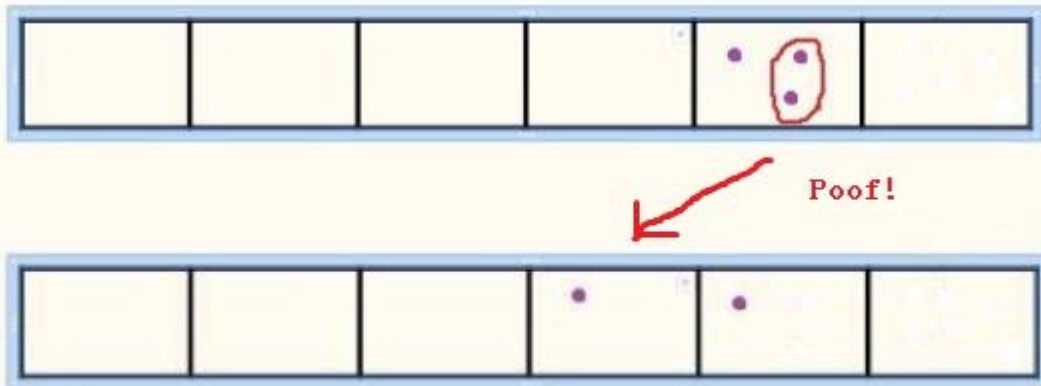
The Machine keeps going until it reaches equilibrium...
